Service Provision – Three Phases of COVID Plan

Phase 1: Urgent COVID

Action = Responding to the immediate needs of consumers, providing services and making referrals to ADRC partners.

Population = Age 60 or older; Caregivers; Individuals age 18 – 59 living with a disability

Priority Focus = Providing needed services such as: Information & Assistance, Nutrition (Meals & Food either Home Delivered or Drive By), Reassurance Calls, Behavioral Health Supports

Service Options = Any of the services that fall into the 3 categories:

- 1) Information & Service Assistance;
- 2) Nutrition & Health Promotion; and
- 3) Services to Promote Independence.

Phase 2: Recovery COVID

Action = Responding to the needs of consumers; Providing OAA services and making referrals to ADRC partners.

Population = Age 60 or older; Caregivers; Individuals age 18 – 59 living with a disability

Priority Focus = Transitioning to new methods of providing services, Strengthening ADRC partnerships, Establishing or enhancing IRTC, Create strategies to address Social Isolation, Evaluate how to strengthen Family Caregiver supports.

Service Options = Any of the services that fall into the 3 categories:

- 1) Information & Service Assistance;
- 2) Nutrition & Health Promotion; and
- 3) Services to Promote Independence.

Phase 3: Post COVID

Action = Return to Standard process and following the Reporting Manual (new normal) – stronger more stable moving forward

Population = Age 60 or older; Caregivers; Individuals age 18 – 59 living with a disability

Priority Focus = Growing and strengthening Iowa Return to Community, Strategies for Home Modification resources and installation, Implement strategies to address Social Isolation, Nutrition & Health Promotion Innovation, Strengthening ADRC Partnerships, Implement strategies that strengthen Family Caregiver Supports

Service Options = Any of the services that fall into the 3 categories:

- 1) Information & Service Assistance;
- 2) Nutrition & Health Promotion; and
- 3) Services to Promote Independence.
